Dress rehearsal will also be held at Clinton High School. Dress rehearsal will be split into 2 days. Dress Rehearsal for shows 1 & 2 will be on Wednesday, June 14th. Dress Rehearsal for show 3 will be Thursday, June 15th. There will be NO classes on these days. There will be normal classes on Monday 6/12 and Tuesday 6/13.

Call time for dress rehearsal is 4:00pm on both days with hair and makeup done. Dress rehearsal will be 4:30-8:00pm and we will run in order of the show, however we will start with the finale/bows so dancers can leave after their last dance. Junior and teen competition team dancers do not need to perform at dress rehearsal for shows 1 & 2.

Junior and teen team dancers will rehearse in the third show. *Competitive* solos will NOT be performed at dress rehearsal in any show. Duos, trios and recreational solos WILL be performed. The opening number will not be rehearsed at dress rehearsal in any show.

Dress Rehearsal Notes

Dress Rehearsal is MANDATORY. All students will need full hair, makeup, tights, shoes and costumes for dress rehearsal. Please bring costumes covered to the high school and have students change on-site. Arrive no later than 4:00pm for Dress Rehearsal with hair and makeup done. Girls will have access to the gymnasium to use as a dressing room. Boys may use the men's bathroom. Competitive soloists will NOT be performing their solos at dress rehearsal. However, soloists should bring their solo costumes to dress rehearsal if they're planning on getting photos done in their solo costume. Soloists should find a time to get their solo photos done at their convenience that won't interfere with their group dances.



Recital Notes

- Videography is not allowed! Not only is it distracting to everyone around you, you will also be in violation of NVM's studio policies and creative rights.
- We will have a videographer at the shows and you have the option to order a recital video. Order forms will be sent out soon.
- Flowers will be available for purchase on-site as well as for pre-order. More info on the next page.
- Arrival time - 1 hour before the show begins with hair and makeup done (8:00am for show 1, 10:00am for show 2, 2:00pm for show 3).
- Students may watch the show with you (with a ticket) or stay in the gymnasium with backstage helpers while you watch the show.
- Students should report to/be dropped off to backstage crew 3 dances before their dance and 5 dances before finale.
- Students should report to/be dropped off backstage for finale 3 numbers beforehand.
- Audience - Please stay seated and be respectful while a dancers are performing. You will only be allowed to enter and exit auditorium between routines (unless emergency) as the doors opening and closing distracts dancers on stage!

***Please bring plenty of food and water for your child on both days. Make sure to only eat in designated areas (no food in auditorium).**

Tickets

Cost:

\$20 General Admission

\$5 for NVM students who plan on watching the show.

Tickets will go on sale **Sunday, June 6th at 6PM.**

We will be doing general admission this year, meaning you won't need to choose your seats ahead of time.

A link to purchase tickets on TutuTix will be sent out via email. Your code to purchase tickets will be your email used on the parent portal (all lowercase).

Codes will be deactivated if your account balance isn't paid in full.

Tickets will be limited to 8 per family per show for the first week of ticket sales. We will then open up sales to families who want to purchase more tickets. It will be first come first serve and we will let you know via email when the extra tickets are going on sale.

We will continue selling tickets up until the time of the first show as long as they are still available.

Free for Toddlers/small children who plan to sit on a parents lap.

The reason we charge NVM students for a ticket is because seating is assigned, and we want to ensure that they would actually be using the ticket since we have sold out in the past and turned family members away from viewing the show.



Account Balances

In order to purchase recital tickets, account balances must be paid through May. Balances must be paid in full by June 10th in order to participate in recital.

June tuition is not pro-rated as tuition is based on an annual amount of 35 classes and divided amongst the months into equal payments.

Picture Day

Picture Day will be held during dress rehearsal this year.



Picture Day will be done by Justin Murray Photography on Wednesday, June 14th and Thursday, June 15th during dress rehearsal. Once dancers are dressed and ready for their performance, they will take their group photo in the hallway before going on stage. Dancers also have the option for individual photos in their costumes. Teen and junior team dancers will do their group photos during dress rehearsal for show 3.

Hair & Makeup

Stage makeup is required so that the dancer's face stands out onstage and so we can see their facial expressions. Dance is an art of expression, and to see expression under heavy stage lighting, stage makeup is required.

Our tiniest dancers should just wear whatever makeup parents feel comfortable applying, but at the minimum, blush and lipstick. Makeup is optional for male dancers.

**please get exact shades or something
VERY similar:*

- **Foundation:** anything to match students skin
- **Blush:** Covergirl Cheekers "Peach Gilt" #109
- **EyeShadow:** Maybelline 12-Pan Eyeshadow Palette - The Nudes (or any dark brown eyeshadow)
- **Lipstick:** Maybelline "plum paradise" #425
- **Eyeliners:** Black
- **Eyelashes:** Black mascara or fake eyelashes

Step 1: Apply foundation all over face with concealer.

Step 2: Apply a light brown color eyeshadow all over the eyelid.

Step 3: Apply a dark shade of brown on the outer side of the eyelid coming in towards the center.

Step 4: Apply black eyeliner along the top of upper eyelid, creating a small wing slightly upward. Add eyeliner along the lower lash line from the wing to the center of the pupil.

Step 5: If your child has light eyebrows, we suggest filling them in with a very light shade of brown. This is optional.

Step 6: Apply mascara to the top and bottom lashes, or apply false eyelashes.

Step 7: Apply blush on the apples of your cheeks and slightly upwards towards your temples.

Step 8: Apply lipstick.

Competition Dances

All competition dances will have a low pony, center part EXCEPT for Junior Lyrical and Select Tap. Junior lyrical will be a high bun and tap will be a low bun. Soloists, duos and trios can do their preferred hair style if time allows.

Opening Number

For the opening number, dancers will wear the recital t-shirt and black bottoms. Bottoms can be pants or shorts. It's okay if they have a logo. Dancer should have their hair in the style that they need for their first dance of the show. Dancers can also wear tights under shorts/pants if needed. Dancers can choose to go barefoot or wear tan jazz shoes.
